E te whānau a te Karaiti | Dear friends in Christ,
God is love, God gives us life.

We love because God first loves us.

In baptism God declares that love;
in Christ God calls us to respond.

The Presentation for Baptism

Families, sponsors/godparents say

*We present **Name** to be baptised and made a member of
the Body of Christ, the Church.*

Today is a special day when we welcome *N*
into the family of God and into the community
of this Christian Church here at St Peter's Cathedral.

The early church received believers by baptism.
On the day when the apostles first preached
the Gospel of Christ's resurrection,
Peter urged his hearers,

*'Repent and be baptised, every one of you,
in the name of Jesus Christ
for the forgiveness of your sins,
and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
For the promise is to you and to your children,
and to all who are far away, to all who
the Lord our God may call.'*

The Church receives you with aroha and joy.
Today we are trusting God for your growth in faith.

N, how do you respond to this promise?

I hear God's call and ask for baptism.

Will you pray for *N*, and guide *her/him* in Christ's way?

With the help of God, we will.

Will you care and love *N*, and share your faith with *her/him*?

Candidates, families, sponsors/godparents say

With the help of God, we will.

Do you renounce all evil influences and powers that rebel against God?

Families, sponsors/godparents say

We renounce all evil.

Do you trust in Christ's victory which brings forgiveness, freedom and life?

In faith I turn and come to Christ, my way, my truth, my life.

Faithful and loving God,

Bless those who care for *N* and grant them your gifts of love, wisdom and faith.

Pour upon them your healing and reconciling love, and protect their homes from all evil.

Fill them with the light of your presence

and establish them in the joy of your kingdom. **Amen.**

The Baptism

Thank you God for your love in all creation,
especially for your gift of water to sustain,
refresh and cleanse all life.

We thank you for the example of your Son that
in the waters of the Jordan he was baptised by John
and anointed with the Holy Spirit.

Through the deep waters of death Jesus fulfilled his baptism.
He died to set us free and was raised to be exalted Lord of all.
It is Christ who baptises with the Holy Spirit.

Sanctify this water, by the power of your Holy Spirit,
that we may be cleansed from sin and born again.
Renewed in your image, may we walk by the light of faith
and continue for ever in the risen life of Jesus Christ our Lord.

Amen! Blessed be God forever.

N,
I baptise you in the name of the Father,
and of the Son,
and of the Holy Spirit.

Amen!

God receives you by baptism into the Church.

We welcome you child of God,

blessed in the Spirit. Welcome to the family of Christ!

I sign you with the cross, the sign of Christ.

You are marked & set apart as His own today, and always.

A parishioner will now present a candle to the newly baptised

Walk in the faith of Christ
crucified and risen.
Shine with the light of Christ.

As the community of faith, we rejoice at this baptism
and will share with *N* what we ourselves have received:
a delight in prayer, a love for the word of God,
a desire to follow the way of Christ,
and food for the journey.

N, you are now a pilgrim with us,
as a member of Christ's body, the Church.
May you grow in the Holy Spirit, fulfil your purpose in the world
and follow Jesus Christ all the days of your life.

may *N* find in you, your homes and families
Christ's love, grace and understanding.
Amen.
